**Community support fulfills challenge ,  
grant from Kansas Health Foundation**

Legacy Regional Community Foundation announces the fulfillment of two challenge grants from The Kansas Health Foundation.

"Through the generosity and foresight of our incredible donors, we have achieved the goal of putting \$700,000 in our endowment and having the KHF match it with \$350,000," said executive director Pam Moore.

The second grant, a 2 to 1 match for Legacy's operating fund, "puts \$200,000 into action in the day-to-day operations of a non-profit, the outcome of which will be felt within Legacy for years to come," said Moore.

But for Legacy the excitement of the achievement is more than the money.

"The real value of the money is what it can become through the community foundation," said Moore.

"In 2007, Legacy gifted more than \$150,000 to our community
